A BILL TO AMEND THE ALBERTA SURVEYS ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends The Alberta Surveys Act, being chapter 75 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

The definition of the term "Director of Surveys" is struck out and a new definition substituted in its stead. The new definition refers to *The Surveys and Expropriation Act* under which the Director of Surveys will be appointed following the division of the Department of Public Works into two new Departments and the repeal of *The Public Works Department Act* and *The Public Works Act*.

This amendment comes into force on a date to be fixed by proclamation so that it may be made effective on the date upon which the division of the Department becomes effective.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Alberta Surveys Act, being chapter 75 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. Section 2 is amended by striking out clause (c) and $\frac{\text{Section 2}}{\text{amended}}$ by substituting the following:

"(c) 'Director of Surveys' means the Director of Sur- "Director of veys appointed under The Surveys and Expropria-^{Surveys"} tion Act;".

3. This Act shall come into force on a date to be fixed by Coming Proclamation of the Lieutenant Governor in Council.
