A BILL TO AMEND THE PURE-BRED SIRE AREA ACT.

Note.

This Bill amends *The Pure-Bred Sire Area Act*, being chapter 95 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 3 (1) is amended by inserting the word "resident" immediately preceding the word "ratepayers". The effect of this amendment is that on a petition signed by at least two-thirds of the "resident ratepayers" the Minister of Agriculture may, with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, direct that any municipal area be constituted, or be included in, or added to a purebred sire area. The signatures of non-resident ratepayers are not required for such petition.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of July, 1951.
