A BILL TO AMEND THE PIPE LINE ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Pipe Line Act*, being chapter 315 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 2, clause (d) is amended in order to enlarge the definition of "pipe line" to include pipe lines transporting water incidental to the drilling for or production of gas or petroleum. It is found that in the drilling of oil wells it is sometimes necessary to install a water disposal system to get rid of salt or other water which has come to the surface with the petroleum. In order to do this it may be necessary to construct pipe lines and this amendment is to enable these lines to be brought under the provisions of *The Pipe Line Act*.

The Bill comes into force upon assent.

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** *The Pipe Line Act*, being chapter 315 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

**2.** Section 2, clause (d) is amended by striking out the words "or petroleum," and by substituting the words " , petroleum or water incidental to the drilling for or production of gas or petroleum,". Section 2 amended

**3.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to. Coming into force
