A BILL TO AMEND THE TELEPHONE AND  
TELEGRAPH ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Telephone and Telegraph Act*, being chapter 198 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 9a (3) is amended. Section 9a provides that the Provincial Treasurer, with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, may advance to the Minister of Railways and Telephones, out of the General Revenue Fund, such sums as may be required from time to time for the capital cost of constructing and extending telephone and telegraph systems. The effect of the amendment is that the aggregate amount of such sums so advanced shall not exceed the sum of five million dollars for the fiscal year 1951-52.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of April, 1951.

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** *The Telephone and Telegraph Act*, being chapter 198 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

**2.** Section 9a, subsection (3) is amended,—

- (a) by striking out the word and figures “year 1950-51” and by substituting the words and figures “fiscal year 1951-52”;
- (b) by striking out the word “six” and by substituting the word “five”.

**3.** This Act shall come into force on the first day of April, 1951. Coming into force
