

Bill No. 70 of 1951.

A BILL TO AMEND THE LIVE STOCK DISEASES ACT

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Live Stock Diseases Act*, being chapter 10 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1946.

Section 6 is amended by striking out the words "Provincial Veterinarian" and by substituting the words "Director of Veterinary Services" to conform with the change in the name of that official in the Department of Agriculture.

Section 7*a*, subsection (3) is amended to bring the Act in conformity with the Dominion and Provincial policy now in operation. The effect of the amendment is that section 7*a* does not apply to a sale of heifers under the age of thirty-six months in a negative herd, or thirty months in an infected herd.

The Bill comes into force upon assent.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Live Stock Diseases Act*, being chapter 10 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1946, is hereby amended.

2. Section 6 is amended by striking out the words "Provincial Veterinarian" and by substituting the words "Director of Veterinary Services". Section 6 amended

3. Section 7a, subsection (3) is amended by striking out the words "eighteen months which have been vaccinated against Brucellosis by a registered veterinary surgeon" and by substituting the words "thirty-six months in a negative herd and under the age of thirty months in an infected herd". Section 7a amended

4. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to. Coming into force
