A BILL TO AMEND THE COMPANIES ACT

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Companies Act*, being chapter 240 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 45 (2), section 58 (1) (d), section 75 (5) (b) and section 119 (1) (a) are each amended.

The effect of these amendments is to delete those references to shares as being designated by distinguishing numbers, as there appears to be no necessity for a distinguishing number for each share.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of July, 1951.

# BILL

No. 71 of 1951.

An Act to amend The Companies Act.

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** *The Companies Act*, being chapter 240 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

**2.** Section 45, subsection (2) is amended by striking out the words "and distinguishing by their appropriate numbers the shares fully paid, partly paid, and forfeited, as the case may be," Section 45 amended

**3.** Section 58, subsection (1), clause (d) is amended by striking out the words "distinguished by their appropriate numbers," Section 58 amended

**4.** Section 75, subsection (5), clause (b) is amended by striking out the words ", distinguishing each share by its number" Section 75 amended

**5.** Section 119, subsection (1), clause (a) is amended by striking out the words "the number," Section 119 amended

**6.** This Act shall come into force on the first day of July, 1951. Coming into force
