A BILL TO AMEND THE WELDING ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Welding Act*, being chapter 322 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 2(a) is amended by striking out the words "the Minister of Public Works" and by substituting the words "that member of the Executive Council who is charged with the administration of this Act". The effect of this amendment is to place the administration of this Act with such member of the Executive Council as may be designated. It is the intention that the Act be administered by the Minister of Industries and Labour.

Section 3 is struck out because it is no longer necessary.

Section 9 is amended for purposes of clarification and so that it conforms with section 10. Both sections will now prohibit any person who is not the holder of a certificate of proficiency from engaging in or undertaking any welding operations.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of April, 1951.

H^{IS} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Welding Act, being chapter 322 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. Section 2, clause (a) is amended by striking out the Section 2 amended words "the Minister of Public Works" and by substituting the words "that member of the Executive Council who is charged with the administration of this Act".

3. Section 3 is repealed.

4. Section 9 is struck out and the following is substi- Section 9 amended tuted:

"9. No person shall engage in or undertake any welding Certificate of operation unless he is the holder of a valid certificate of proficiency under this Act.".

5. This Act shall come into force on the first day of Coming . April, 1951.
