# BILL

#### No. 89 of 1951.

An Act for Granting to His Majesty Certain Sums of Money for the Public Service for the Fiscal Years Ending Respectively the Thirty-first day of March, 1950, the Thirty-first day of March, 1951, and the Thirtyfirst day of March, 1952.

> (Assented to , 1951.)

Most Gracious Sovereign:

WHEREAS it appears by Messages from His Honour Preamble John J. Bowlen, Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Alberta, and the Estimates accompanying the said Messages, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Public Service of Alberta not otherwise provided for during the financial periods ending respectively the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and fifty; the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-one, and the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-two, and for other purposes relating thereto:

May it therefore please Your Majesty that it be enacted. and be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Appropriation Act, Short title 1951".

2. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may Appropriabe paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole two for 1949-1950 hundred and fifty-five thousand, one hundred and sixty-five dollars and seventy-eight cents, towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and fortynine, to the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and fifty, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule A to this Act.

3. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may Appropria-be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole six for 1950-1951million, eight hundred and sixteen thousand, six hundred and thirty-nine dollars and fifty-three cents, towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of April, one thousand nine

hundred and fifty, to the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-one, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule B to this Act.

Appropriation for 1951-1952 be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole one hundred and two million, fifty-four thousand, six hundred and ten dollars, towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of April, one thousand, nine hundred and fifty-one, to the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-two, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule C to this Act.

Accountability for 5. The due application of all moneys expended under this expenditures Act shall be accounted for.

Coming into force

6. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
