

Bill No. 13 of 1952.

A BILL TO AMEND THE HIGHWAYS DEPARTMENT
ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Highways Department Act*, being chapter 39 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1951.

Section 10, subsection (3) of the Act provides that the net amount of the advances (made from the General Revenue Fund to the stock advance fund) at any time shall not exceed three million seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars. The effect of the amendment is to increase this maximum to four million six hundred and fifty thousand dollars.

The amendment is made retroactive to the 7th day of May, 1951, on which date order in council 627-51 was passed. On the 19th day of November, 1951, order in council 1672-51 was passed. Both orders in council were passed subject to the enactment of a retroactive amendment to the above effect being enacted at this session of the Legislature.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Highways Department Act*, being chapter 39 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1951, is hereby amended.

2. Section 10, subsection (3) is amended by striking out the words "three million seven" and by substituting the words "four million six". Section 10 amended

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to and upon so coming into force shall be deemed to have been in force at all times on and after the seventh day of May, 1951. Coming into force
