A BILL TO AMEND THE STATUTES ACT

NOTE.

This Bill amends The Statutes Act, being chapter 2 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 4 is amended by the addition of a new subsection (3). This new subsection makes it clear that where the Lieutenant Governor in Council is authorized to proclaim a date on which an Act shall come into force the whole Act may be proclaimed as of one date or any part or section may be proclaimed from time to time.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

 \mathbf{H}^{IS} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Statutes Act, being chapter 2 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. Section 4 is amended by adding immediately after sub- Section 4 section (2) the following new subsection:

"(3) Where an Act provides that it is to come into force Proclamaon a date to be fixed by proclamation of the Lieutenant ^{tion} Governor in Council or that it is not to come into force until a day to be so named, any such proclamation may apply to the whole or any part or section of the Act and proclamations may be issued at different times as to any part or section of the Act.".

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which $Coming_{into force}^{Coming}$ it is assented to.
