

Bill No. 22 of 1952.

A BILL TO REPEAL THE PROVINCIAL INDUSTRIES
DEVELOPMENT ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill repeals *The Provincial Industries Development Act*, being chapter 317 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

The matters that this Act dealt with are now more adequately covered by other legislation. Financial assistance to new industries is now administered by the Alberta Industrial Corporation under the provisions of *The Alberta Industrial Corporation Act*, being chapter 7 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1946. In addition the Industrial Development and Economic Research Branch of the Department of Economic Affairs is now actively engaged in encouraging and assisting in the establishment of new manufacturing industries in the Province. Accordingly, as the provisions of *The Provincial Industries Development Act* are no longer used the Act is repealed.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.
