

Bill No. 33 of 1952.

A BILL TO AMEND THE DAIRYMEN'S ACT, 1950.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Dairymen's Act*, being chapter 18 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1950.

The former subsections (3) and (4) of section 38 provided that the assessments which may be made by the Minister on the owner of a dairy manufacturing plant to defray a proportion of the costs of the services of inspectors, graders, testers and weighers, should be deposited by the Minister in a chartered bank, or treasury branch, in a special trust fund. The Dairy Commissioner was to pay all proper expenditures or charges for the services of the inspectors, graders, testers and weighers out of the trust fund.

Subsections (3) and (4) are now struck out and a new subsection (3) is substituted. The effect of this amendment is to provide that the revenue obtained from the assessments shall be placed in the general revenue fund for the Province and the special trust fund of the Minister is abolished.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Dairymen's Act, 1950*, being chapter 18 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1950, is hereby amended.

2. Section 38 is amended by striking out subsections (3) and (4) and by substituting the following: Section 38 amended

“(3) The assessments when received by the Minister shall be paid to the Provincial Treasurer and thereupon they shall form part of the General Revenue Fund of the Province.”.

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to. Coming into force
