A BILL TO AMEND THE VEGETABLE SALES (ALBERTA) ACT

NOTE.

This Bill amends The Vegetable Sales (Alberta) Act, being chapter 87 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Clause (d) of section 2 is amended. By the amendment the definition of "vegetable" is changed. At present the Act applies only to vegetables "grown in the Province". The amendment broadens the application of the Act to cover potatoes "offered for sale" in the Province and any other plant whether grown in the Province or not that is designated by the Lieutenant Governor in Council as a vegetable. Formerly vegetable was defined as potatoes "grown in the Province" and any other plants "grown in the Province" which were designated vegetables by the Lieutenant Governor in Council. The amendment is designed to facilitate the undertaking by the Federal Government of complete grading and inspection services in connection with potatoes and other vegetables.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Vegetable Sales (Alberta) Act, being chapter 87 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.
- **2.** Section 2, clause (d) is amended by striking out the Section 2 words "grown in the Province and any other plant grown in the Province" and by substituting the words "offered for sale in the Province and any other plant".
- 3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which $\frac{\text{Coming}}{\text{into force}}$ it is assented to.
