A BILL TO AMEND THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY  
ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Legislative Assembly Act*, being chapter 4 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 11 is amended by adding a new subsection (5). The effect of this amendment is to make it permissible for a Member of the Legislative Assembly to purchase a retirement annuity, under *The Retirement Annuities Act*, from the Alberta Government irrespective of subsection (1). That subsection prevents a person sitting or voting in the Legislative Assembly or being eligible to be a Member thereof while enjoying the benefit of a contract or agreement with the Government under which public money is paid to him.

Schedule 1 is amended. This Schedule contains the descriptions of the various electoral divisions in the Province. Adjustments have been made in the boundaries of electoral divisions of Edson, Rocky Mountain House, St. Albert and Stony Plain which necessitate changes in the legal descriptions of these divisions in the Schedule.

This Bill shall come into force upon assent.

# BILL

No. 41 of 1952.

An Act to amend The Legislative Assembly Act.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1952.)

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Legislative Assembly Act*, being chapter 4 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. Section 11 is amended by adding immediately after subsection (4) the following new subsection: Section 11  
amended

“(5) Subsection (1) shall not apply to a contract or an agreement entered into by a Member of the Legislative Assembly with Her Majesty or any public officer or department of the public service of Alberta for the purchase of a retirement annuity under the provisions of “*The Retirement Annuities Act*”.

3. Schedule 1 is amended,—

(a) by striking out the legal description of the Electoral Division of Edson and by substituting the following: Schedule  
amended

“**Electorial Division of Edson**, the boundary whereof is as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of township 64, range 14, west of the 6th meridian and the Inter-Provincial Boundary between Alberta and British Columbia; thence easterly along the north boundary of township 64, ranges 14 to 1 inclusive, west of the 6th meridian and ranges 27 to 21 inclusive, west of the 5th meridian to an intersection with the Little Smoky River; thence northerly along the Little Smoky River to its intersection with the north boundary of township 65, range 21, west of the 5th meridian; thence easterly along the north boundary of township 65, ranges 21 to 18 inclusive, west of the 5th meridian to the north-east corner of township 65, range 18, west of the 5th meridian; thence southerly along the meridian between ranges 17 and 18 to the north-east corner of township 57, range 18, west of the 5th meridian; thence easterly along the north boundary of township 57, ranges 17 to 13 inclusive, west of the 5th meridian to an intersection with the left bank of the Macleod River;

thence southerly along the said left bank to an intersection with the north boundary of township 55, range 13, west of the 5th meridian; thence easterly along the north boundary of township 55, ranges 13 to 10 inclusive, west of the 5th meridian to the north-east corner of township 55, range 10, west of the 5th meridian; thence southerly along the meridian between ranges 9 and 10 to the south-east corner of township 55, range 10, west of the 5th meridian; thence easterly along the north boundary of township 54, range 9, west of the 5th meridian to the north-east corner of township 54, range 9, west of the 5th meridian; thence southerly along the meridian between ranges 8 and 9 to the south-east corner of township 51, range 9, west of the 5th meridian; thence westerly along the north boundary of township 50, ranges 9 to 11 inclusive, west of the 5th meridian to the north-east corner of township 50, range 12, west of the 5th meridian; thence southerly along the meridian between ranges 11 and 12 to the north-east corner of township 47, range 12, west of the 5th meridian; thence westerly along the north boundary of township 47, ranges 12 to 14 inclusive, to the north-east corner of township 47, range 15, west of the 5th meridian; thence southerly along the meridian between ranges 14 and 15, to the south-east corner of township 43, range 15, west of the 5th meridian; thence westerly along the north boundary of township 42, ranges 15 to 19 inclusive, west of the 5th meridian to the north-east corner of township 42, range 20, west of the 5th meridian; thence southerly along the meridian between ranges 19 and 20 to an intersection with the Inter-Provincial Boundary between Alberta and British Columbia; thence in a generally north-westerly direction along the said Inter-Provincial Boundary to the point of commencement.”;

- (b) by striking out the legal description of the Electoral division of Rocky Mountain House and by substituting the following:

**“Electoral Division of Rocky Mountain House**, the boundary whereof is as follows: Commencing at the north-east corner of township 47, range 15, west of the 5th meridian; thence southerly on the projection of the meridian between ranges 14 and 15, west of the 5th meridian to the south-east corner of township 43, range 15, west of the 5th meridian; thence westerly along the projection of the north boundary of township 42, ranges 15 to 19 inclusive, west of the 5th meridian; thence southerly along the meridian between ranges 19 and 20 to the intersection of the said meridian with the Inter-Provincial Boundary

between Alberta and British Columbia; thence in a south-easterly direction to an intersection with the projected north boundary of township 32, range 19, west of the 5th meridian; thence easterly along the projected north boundary of township 32, ranges 19 to 14 inclusive, west of the 5th meridian to the easterly boundary of the Banff National Park; thence in a generally south-easterly direction along the said easterly boundary to an intersection with the projected north boundary of township 31, range 13, west of the 5th meridian; thence easterly along the north boundary of township 31, ranges 13 to 9 inclusive, west of the 5th meridian to the north-east corner of township 31, range 9, west of the 5th meridian; thence northerly along the projected meridian between ranges 8 and 9 to the north-east corner of township 34, range 9, west of the 5th meridian; thence easterly along the north boundary of township 34, ranges 8 to 4 inclusive, west of the 5th meridian to the north-east corner of township 34, range 4, west of the 5th meridian; thence northerly along the meridian between ranges 3 and 4 to the north-east corner of township 36, range 4, west of the 5th meridian; thence easterly along the north boundary of township 36, ranges 3, 2 and 1, west of the 5th meridian to an intersection with the fifth principal meridian; thence northerly along the said meridian to an intersection with the Blindman River; thence north-westerly along the said Blindman River to an intersection with the north boundary of township 39, range 1, west of the 5th meridian; thence westerly along the north boundary of township 39, ranges 1 to 5 inclusive, west of the 5th meridian to the north-east corner of township 39, range 6, west of the 5th meridian; thence northerly along the meridian between ranges 5 and 6 to the north-east corner of township 41, range 6, west of the 5th meridian; thence westerly along the north boundary of township 41, ranges 6, 7 and 8 to an intersection with the left bank of the North Saskatchewan River; thence in a generally northerly direction along the said left bank to an intersection with the north boundary of township 46, range 9, west of the 5th meridian; thence westerly along the north boundary of township 46, ranges 9, 10 and 11 to the north-east corner of township 46, range 12, west of the 5th meridian; thence northerly along the meridian between ranges 11 and 12 to the north-east corner of township 47, range 12, west of the 5th meridian; thence westerly along the north boundary of township 47 and of the projection westerly thereof, ranges 12 to 14 inclusive, west of the 5th meridian to the point of commencement.”;

- (c) by striking out the legal description of the Electoral Division of St. Albert and by substituting the following:

**“Electoral Division of St. Albert,** the boundary whereof is as follows: Commencing at the north-east corner of section 12, township 59, range 1, west of the 5th meridian; thence southerly along the fifth principal meridian to the north-east corner of township 53, range 1, west of the 5th meridian; thence easterly along the north boundary of township 53, ranges 28 and 27, west of the 4th meridian to the north-east corner of township 53, range 27, west of the 4th meridian; thence southerly along the meridian between ranges 26 and 27 to the intersection with Atim Creek; thence easterly downstream along Atim Creek to its outlet into Big Lake; thence in a generally southerly and north-easterly direction along the westerly and southerly shores of Big Lake to the intersection with the north boundary of section 19, township 53, range 25, west of the 4th meridian; thence easterly along the north boundary of sections 19 to 24 inclusive, township 53, range 25, west of the 4th meridian and of sections 19 to 24 inclusive of township 53, range 24, west of the 4th meridian and of section 19, township 53, range 23, west of the 4th meridian to an intersection with the left bank of the North Saskatchewan River; thence in a generally north-easterly direction downstream along the left bank of the North Saskatchewan River to an intersection with the north boundary of township 56, range 20, west of the 4th meridian; thence westerly along the north boundary of township 56, ranges 20 to 23 inclusive, west of the 4th meridian to the north-east corner of township 56, range 24, west of the 4th meridian; thence northerly along the meridian between ranges 23 and 24 to the north-east corner of section 12, township 59, range 24, west of the 4th meridian; thence westerly along the north boundary of sections 12 to 7 inclusive, township 59, range 24, west of the 4th meridian; and sections 12 to 7 inclusive, of township 59, range 25, west of the 4th meridian; and sections 12 to 7 inclusive of township 59, range 26, west of the 4th meridian and of sections 12 to 9 inclusive of township 59, range 27, west of the 4th meridian to the north-east corner of section 12, township 59, range 1, west of the 5th meridian, being the point of commencement.”;

- (d) by striking out the legal description of the Electoral Division of Stony Plain and by substituting the following:

**“Electoral Division of Stony Plain,** the boundary whereof is as follows: Commencing at the north-

east corner of township 54, range 9, west of the 5th meridian; thence easterly along the north boundary of township 54, ranges 8 and 7 to the north-east corner of township 54, range 7, west of the 5th meridian; thence southerly along the meridian between ranges 6 and 7 to the north-east corner of township 53, range 7, west of the 5th meridian; thence easterly along the north boundary of township 53, ranges 6 to 1 inclusive, west of the 5th meridian and ranges 28 and 27, west of the 4th meridian to the north-east corner of township 53, range 27, west of the 4th meridian; thence southerly along the meridian between ranges 26 and 27 to the intersection with Atim Creek; thence easterly downstream along Atim Creek to its outlet into Big Lake; thence in a generally southerly and north-easterly direction along the westerly and southerly shores of Big Lake to the intersection with the north boundary of section 19, township 53, range 25, west of the 4th meridian; thence easterly along the north boundary of sections 19, 20 and 21 to the north-east corner of the said section 21; thence southerly along the east boundary of sections 21, 16, 9 and 4, township 53, range 25, west of the 4th meridian and sections 33, 28, 21 and 16, township 52, range 25, west of the 4th meridian to the intersection with the left bank of the North Saskatchewan River; thence in a generally south-westerly direction upstream along the said left bank to the intersection with the north boundary of township 46, range 9, west of the 5th meridian; thence westerly along the north boundary of township 46, ranges 9, 10 and 11 to the north-east corner of township 46, range 12, west of the 5th meridian; thence northerly along the meridian between ranges 11 and 12 to the north-east corner of township 50, range 12, west of the 5th meridian; thence easterly along the north boundary of township 50, ranges 9, 10 and 11 to the south-east corner of township 51, range 9, west of the 5th meridian; thence northerly along the meridian between ranges 8 and 9 to the point of commencement.”.

4. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to. Coming into force
