H^{ER} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Self-Liquidating Projects Act, being chapter 67 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1950, is hereby amended.

2. Section 6, subsection (1) is amended by striking out Section 6 the word "twelve" and by substituting the word "seventeen".

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which $Coming_{into force}$ it is assented to.
