

Bill No. 60 of 1952.

A BILL TO AMEND THE AMUSEMENTS ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Amusements Act*, being chapter 40 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 6 is amended to correct a cross-reference.

Section 13 is amended. Subsection (1) clause (a) is amended to provide that no amusement tax shall be collected upon admission fees to rodeos, fairs and stampedes. Previously the exemption applied only to agricultural fairs. Subsection (2) is amended. Where a professional is employed the exemptions to the amusement tax did not apply. By this amendment the employment of professionals at agricultural fairs, rodeos, fairs and stampedes and exhibitions of paintings and works of art will not necessitate the charging of the amusement tax.

Section 17 is amended. The operator of a moving picture machine was required, among other conditions, to pay an "annual" license fee before he could use or operate such a machine for public display of pictures. He is now required to pay a license fee for a "permanent" license.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of July, 1952.

An Act to amend The Amusements Act.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Amusements Act*, being chapter 40 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. Section 6, subsection (1) is amended by striking out the words "license issued under paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section 3" and by substituting the words "valid and subsisting license as required by clause (c) of subsection (1) of section 3". Section 6
amended

3. Section 13 is amended,— Section 13
amended
(a) by adding immediately after the word "Act," where it occurs in clause (a) of subsection (1), the words "rodeos, fairs and stampedes,";
(b) by striking out the words "this section" where they occur in subsection (2), and by substituting the words and letters "in clauses (b), (c), (d), (f) and (g)".

4. Section 17, clause (b) is amended by striking out the word "annual". Section 17
amended

5. This Act shall come into force on the first day of July, 1952. Coming
