# A BILL TO AMEND THE MATERNITY HOSPITALIZATION ACT.

#### NOTE.

This Bill amends The Maternity Hospitalization Act, being chapter 9 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1944.

A new section 5b is added. It provides that the Minister may pay a hospitalization grant on a per diem basis for a woman who is entitled to hospitalization and who is hospitalized in an approved hospital which has not entered into an agreement under this Act with the Minister. The grant will be in such an amount as may be prescribed by regulations from time to time.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Maternity Hospitalization Act, being chapter 9 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1944, is hereby amended.
- **2.** The following new section is added immediately after New section section 5a:
- "5b. (1) The Minister may pay to any woman who re-tion grant ceives hospitalization in an approved hospital which has not entered into an agreement with the Minister under this Act. a grant on a *per diem* basis for a period of hospitalization not exceeding twelve days, if the woman,—
  - "(a) is entitled to hospitalization under this Act and the regulations;
  - "(b) submits an account from the approved hospital for her hospitalization.
- "(2) The grant shall be of such an amount as may be prescribed from time to time by regulations.".
- 3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which Coming it is assented to.
