

Bill No. 87 of 1952.

A BILL TO AMEND THE VENDORS' AND
MORTGAGEES' COSTS EXACTION ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Vendors' and Mortgagees' Costs Exaction Act*, being chapter 149 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 2 is amended by adding a new clause (b) and by relettering the present clause (b) as clause (c). The effect of the amendment is to permit a party to a mortgage of land, a chattel mortgage, an agreement for sale of land, or any agreement for sale or conditional sale of any personal property, to agree to assume liability for the payment of the costs and disbursements in respect of the issuing or serving of a statement of claim against him.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of July, 1952.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows:

1. *The Vendors' and Mortgagees' Costs Exaction Act*,
being chapter 149 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942,
is hereby amended.

2. Section 2 is amended:

(a) by adding immediately after clause (a) the follow-
ing new clause:

“(b) the costs and disbursements in respect of the
issuing and serving of a statement of claim;”;

(b) by relettering clause (b) as clause (c).
