This Bill amends *The Forest Reserves Act*, being chapter 25 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1950.

Section 44, subsections (1) and (2) are amended. The effect of this amendment is to make all *The Forests Act* apply to all lands within a forest reserve instead of only Part III of that Act, (Prevention of Forest and Prairie Fires) as was the case.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

- **1.** The Forest Reserves Act, being chapter 25 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1950, is hereby amended.
 - 2. Section 44 is amended:
