A BILL TO AMEND THE TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends The Telephone and Telegraph Act, being chapter 198 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 9a, subsection (3) is amended. This section provides that the Provincial Treasurer, with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, may advance to the Minister of Railways and Telephones, out of the General Revenue Fund, such sums as may be required from time to time for the capital cost of constructing and extending telephone and telegraph systems. The effect of the amendment is that the aggregate amount of such sums so advanced shall not exceed the sum of seven million dollars for the fiscal year 1952-53.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of April, 1952.
