A BILL TO AMEND THE AGRICULTURAL SERVICE  
BOARD ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Agricultural Service Board Act*, being chapter 19 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1945.

Section 10 is amended to make it clear that an agreement for the conservation of soil and water, control of weeds, and such matters, may be made by the Minister with several councils acting together, and that the parties to an agreement are not restricted to the Minister and one council. Also the amendment provides that the council may agree to the building of a seed cleaning plant outside the municipal district at a location mutually agreed upon by the parties to the agreement.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

# BILL

No. 110 of 1952.

An Act to amend The Agricultural Service Board Act.

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** *The Agricultural Service Board Act*, being chapter 19 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1945, is hereby amended.

**2.** Section 10 is amended,—

(a) by adding immediately after the word “council” the words “or any number of councils”;

(b) by adding immediately after clause (d) the following new clause:

“(e) the construction of a seed cleaning plant at a location, within or without the municipal district, mutually agreed upon by the parties concerned and the Minister.”.
