

Bill No. 6 of 1953

A BILL TO AMEND THE FARM MACHINERY ACT

NOTE

This Bill amends *The Farm Machinery Act*, being chapter 222 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

A new section 7 is added. This section provides that it is an offence for a vendor to fail or neglect to keep available for ten years an adequate supply of repair parts required for the farm machinery sold by him or on his behalf in Alberta. Subsection (2) defines "vendor" for the purposes of this new section.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of July, 1953.

# BILL

No. 6 of 1953

An Act to amend The Farm Machinery Act

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1953)

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Farm Machinery Act*, being chapter 222 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. The following new section is added immediately after section 6: New section

"7. (1) A vendor who fails or neglects to keep available Repair parts within the Province, for a period of ten years after the sale of farm machinery sold in the Province by him or on his account, an adequate supply of repair parts for the farm machinery sold by him or on his behalf is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars.

"(2) In this section "vendor" means, "Vendor"

"(a) if the person or company that sold the farm machinery in the Province on his or its own account resides or has its head office in the Province, that person or company,

"(b) if the person or company that sold the farm machinery in the Province on his or its own account resides or has its head office outside the Province,

"(i) his or its chief distributor in Alberta, when he or it has a chief distributor therein, or

"(ii) his or its agent in Alberta when he or it has no chief distributor in the Province."

3. This Act comes into force on the first day of July, Coming into force 1953.
