

Bill No. 14 of 1953

A BILL TO AMEND THE CONTROVERTED  
MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS ACT

NOTE

This Bill amends *The Controverted Municipal Elections Act*, being chapter 155 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 35 is struck out and a new section substituted. The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the meaning of the old section by enumerating more fully the material the section requires a judge, who hears the appeal of an election or voting by-law result, to return to the court office after his decision, to remain of record as a judgment of the court.

Section 43 is repealed. This section was obsolete and served no useful purpose.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of July, 1953.

# BILL

No. 14 of 1953

An Act to amend The Controverted Municipal Elections Act.

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** *The Controverted Municipal Elections Act*, being chapter 155 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

**2.** Section 35 is struck out and the following is substituted: Section 35  
amended

“**35.** (1) The judge, immediately after his decision, shall return his order together with Return

“(a) the affidavits and material filed by the relator in the proceedings,

“(b) all ballot papers, books, lists and records produced pursuant to section 27, and

“(c) all other matter and things had before him in connection with the proceedings,

to the proper officer of the court in which the proceedings are intituled, there to remain of record as a judgement of the court.

“(2) The judgment of the court may be enforced in the same manner as an ordinary order of *mandamus* of the court and a writ of execution may be issued thereunder to recover any costs awarded by the judgment.”

**3.** Section 43 is repealed.
