## Bill No. 19 of 1953

#### A BILL TO AMEND THE OLD AGE ASSISTANCE ACT

#### NOTE

This Bill amends The Old Age Assistance Act, being chapter 66 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1952.

Section 3 is amended. Subsection (2) is struck out and two new subsections added. Subsection (2) authorizes the payment of old age assistance to persons from 65 years to 69 years of age; and subsection (3) permits payment for the month in which a person attains seventy years of age. No other requirements are affected.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of April, 1953.

## BILL

### No. 19 of 1953

#### An Act to amend The Old Age Assistance Act

(Assented to

, 1953)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Old Age Assistance Act, being chapter 66 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1952, is hereby amended.

2. Section 3 is amended by striking out subsection (2) Section 3 amended and by substituting the following:

"(2) Assistance may be paid in accordance with the agreement made under subsection (1) to a person who, at the date of the proposed commencement of payment to him, has attained the age of sixty-five years but has not attained the age of seventy years.

"(3) Notwithstanding subsection (2), assistance may be paid for the month in which a person attained the age of seventy years.".

3. This Act comes into force on the first day of April, Coming into force 1953.
