

Bill No. 19 of 1953

A BILL TO AMEND THE OLD AGE ASSISTANCE
ACT

NOTE

This Bill amends *The Old Age Assistance Act*, being chapter 66 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1952.

Section 3 is amended. Subsection (2) is struck out and two new subsections added. Subsection (2) authorizes the payment of old age assistance to persons from 65 years to 69 years of age; and subsection (3) permits payment for the month in which a person attains seventy years of age. No other requirements are affected.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of April, 1953.

An Act to amend The Old Age Assistance Act

(Assented to _____, 1953)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Old Age Assistance Act*, being chapter 66 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1952, is hereby amended.

2. Section 3 is amended by striking out subsection (2) and by substituting the following: Section 3 amended

"(2) Assistance may be paid in accordance with the agreement made under subsection (1) to a person who, at the date of the proposed commencement of payment to him, has attained the age of sixty-five years but has not attained the age of seventy years.

"(3) Notwithstanding subsection (2), assistance may be paid for the month in which a person attained the age of seventy years."

3. This Act comes into force on the first day of April, 1953. Coming into force
