This Bill amends The Supplementary Allowances Act, being chapter 89 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1952.

Section 3, subsection (2) is amended by the addition of a new clause (d). This amendment has the effect of excluding from the benefits of this Act a person who is the responsibility of the Canadian Government for purposes of health and welfare services.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of April, 1953.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Supplementary Allowances Act, being chapter 89 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1952, is hereby amended.
 - 2. Section 3, subsection (2) is amended

Section 3 amended

- (a) by adding at the end of clause (c) the word "and";
- (b) by adding immediately after clause (c) the following new clause:
 - "(d) who is not, for the purposes of health and welfare services, the responsibility of the Government of Canada.".
- 3. This Act comes into force on the first day of April, Coming 1953.
