### A BILL TO REPEAL THE ALBERTA HEALTH INSURANCE ACT

#### Note

This Bill repeals The Alberta Health Insurance Act, being chapter 204 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

That Act was replaced by *The Alberta Health Insurance* Act, 1946, and was to have been repealed thereby but the later Act did not come into force. The earlier Act was not in a form that could be implemented and it is therefore repealed.
