A BILL TO REPEAL THE ALBERTA HEALTH

NOTE

This Bill repeals *The Alberta Health Insurance Act*, being chapter 204 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

That Act was replaced by *The Alberta Health Insurance Act*, 1946, and was to have been repealed thereby but the later Act did not come into force. The earlier Act was not in a form that could be implemented and it is therefore repealed.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Alberta Health Insurance Act*, being chapter 204 <sup>Repeal</sup> of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby repealed.

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it <sup>Coming</sup> <sub>into force</sub> assented to.
