#### A BILL TO AMEND THE INTERPRETATION ACT

#### Note

This Bill amends The Interpretation Act, being chapter 1 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 41, clause (i) is amended with respect to the holiday known as Victoria Day. By an Act of the Parliament of Canada this holiday is now fixed as the first Monday preceding May 25th in each year. Previously it was the 24th of May or the 25th of May if the 24th was on a Sunday and was so designated by dates in this clause. It is now simply designated by name.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Interpretation Act, being chapter 1 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.
- 2. Section 41, clause (i) is amended by striking out the Section 41 words "the twenty-fourth day of May or, when such day amended falls on a Sunday, the twenty-fifth day of May to be known as".
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is  $\underset{\text{into force}}{\operatorname{coming}}$  assented to.
