Bill No. 37 of 1953

A BILL TO AMEND THE AGRICULTURAL PESTS ACT

Note

This Bill amends The Agricultural Pests Act, being chapter 76 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1952.

Section 6 is amended to authorize an officer under this Act to enter upon land to prevent infestation of other lands.

Section 20 is amended. This section, which provides for the maximum sum chargeable to a municipality, previously referred to sums charged "under the Act" rather than to sums charged for grasshopper control under Part II of the Act. The amendment clarifies the reference in this section.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of July, 1953.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Agricultural Pests Act, being chapter 76 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. Section 6, subsection (1) is amended by adding im- $\frac{\text{Section 6}}{\text{amended}}$ mediately after the word "thereon," the words "or preventing infestation on that or other land,".

3. Section 20 is amended by striking out the word "Act" Section 20 amended and by substituting the word "Part".

4. This Act comes into force on the first day of July, 1953. Coming into force
