A BILL TO AMEND THE TUBERCULOSIS ACT

Note

This Bill amends *The Tuberculosis Act*, being chapter 195 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 2, clause (c) is amended to remove the reference to the Central Alberta Sanatorium.

Section 3 is amended. The effect of the amendment is to remove the reference to the Central Alberta Sanatorium, and to permit the Minister, with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, to operate sanatoria for the treatment of tuberculosis without reference to any particular sanatorium.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Tuberculosis Act, being chapter 195 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.
- **2.** Section 2, clause (c) is amended by striking out the Section 2 words "the Central Alberta Sanatorium and also".
- **3.** Section 3, clause (a) is amended by striking out the Section 3 words "the Central Alberta Sanatorium as a sanatorium" amended and by substituting the words ", with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, sanatoria".
- 4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is Coming assented to.
