

Bill No. 48 of 1953

A BILL TO AMEND THE AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHIC
SURVEY ACT

NOTE

This Bill amends *The Aerial Photographic Survey Act*, being chapter 1 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1951.

For convenience in reference a definition of the word "regulations" is added to section 2.

Section 6, subsection (1) provides for the posting of a cash deposit by applicants who do not maintain a place of business within the Province. The original subsection is replaced by two new subsections. The principal change is the provision for a smaller cash deposit in cases of operations of a limited nature.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of July, 1953.

An Act to amend The Aerial Photographic Survey Act

(Assented to _____, 1953)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Aerial Photographic Survey Act*, being chapter 1 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1951, is hereby amended.

2. Section 2 is amended by adding immediately after clause (d) the following new clause: Section 2 amended

“(e) ‘regulations’ means the regulations established under this Act.” “regulations”

3. Section 6 is amended by striking out subsection (1) and by substituting the following: Section 6 amended

“**6.** (1) Unless the applicant maintains a place of business within the Province, he shall furnish to the Minister before the issue of a license, a cash bond as guarantee that the aerial photographic survey and other related matters will be conducted in accordance with this Act and the regulations. Cash bond

“(1a) The amount of the cash deposit shall be Amount of cash bond

“(a) the sum of three thousand dollars where the area to be surveyed is over fifty square miles,

“(b) the sum of one thousand dollars where the area to be surveyed is under fifty square miles.”

4. This Act comes into force on the first day of July, 1953. Coming into force
