A BILL TO AMEND THE ALBERTA PHARMACEUTICAL ASSOCIATION ACT, 1945.

Note

This Bill amends The Alberta Pharmaceutical Association Act, 1945, being chapter 15 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1945.

Section 8 is amended. Subsection (1) is amended and two new subsections, (3) and (4), are added. The effect of this amendment is, firstly, to permit the association, by by-law, to set up any number of districts in the Province for the election of councillors, without having the number of districts correspond to the number of councillors to be elected; and, secondly, to enable certain groups of pharmacists, such as hospital pharmacists, to be represented by a councillor whom they may elect as a class and not as members of a district.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of July, 1953.

H^{ER} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Alberta Pharmaceutical Association Act, 1945, being chapter 15 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1945, is hereby amended.

2. Section 8 is amended

- (a) by striking out the words "the same number of districts as there are councillors to be elected", where they occur in subsection (1), and by substituting the word "districts";
- (b) by adding immediately after subsection (2) the following new subsections:
 - "(3) The association, by by-law, may

Election of councillors

- "(a) provide for the election of councillors by certain classes of persons, and
- "(b) designate and define the class of persons who may be represented by a councillor.

"(4) A person entitled to vote for a councillor under a by-law made pursuant to subsection (3) shall not be entitled to vote for a councillor in any district defined pursuant to subsection (2).".
