

Bill No. 58 of 1953.

A BILL TO AMEND THE CHANGE OF NAME ACT.

NOTE

This Bill amends *The Change of Name Act*, being chapter 328 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 3 is amended to permit anyone of nineteen years or over to come within the purview of this Act. Previously only persons twenty-one or over could effect a change of name under the procedure authorized therein.

Form D in the Schedule is amended. A new shorter Form D is substituted which will give the essential information and be considerably less expensive to publish, as is required, in *The Alberta Gazette* and a local newspaper.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of July, 1953.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Change of Name Act*, being chapter 328 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. Section 3 is amended by striking out the words "twenty-one" and by substituting the word "nineteen". Section 3 amended
