A BILL TO AMEND THE RIGHT OF ENTRY ARBITRATION ACT, 1952

Note

This Bill amends The Right of Entry Arbitration Act, 1952, being chapter 79 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1952.

The interpretation section is amended by striking out the definition of "local authority".

Set out in section 10 are the matters for which right of entry may be obtained. Subsection (3) is amended for clarification. Also a provision is added to this section to permit the Board to grant right of entry to an operator who has obtained an appropriate well license for the surface location of a well to be drilled directionally to minerals located outside of the tract with respect to which the surface location is situated.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

An Act to amend The Right of Entry Arbitration Act, 1952

H^{ER} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Right of Entry Arbitration Act, 1952, being chapter 79 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1952, is hereby amended.

2. Section 2 is amended by striking out clause (b).

Section 10 amended

- (a) by striking out the word "further" where it occurs in subsection (3) and by substituting the word "other";
- (b) by adding at the end of subsection (3) the words "irrespective of whether or not the owner or occupant of the other land is the owner or occupant of the surface of the land in which the operator or his principal has the right to the mineral or the right to work the same";

(c) by adding immediately after subsection (3) the following new subsection:

"(3a) Where a license has been obtained to drill a well for the removal of a mineral contained in or underlying the surface of a tract of land and the orifice of the well will be located outside of the tract the Board may grant the right of entry, user or taking of the surface of land outside of the tract in the same manner and to the same extent as if the land were within the tract, irrespective of whether or not the owner or occupant of the surface of the land outside of the tract is the owner or occupant of the surface of land within the tract.".

4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it Coming is assented to.
