A BILL TO REPEAL THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES
INVESTMENTS IN WAR LOANS ACT

NOTE

This Bill repeals *The Local Authorities Investments in War Loans Act*, being chapter 168 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

That Act is no longer operative as it dealt with the purchase of Government of Canada bonds by municipalities "for the purpose of financing the prosecution of the war now being waged", that is World War II.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.
