- 1. The School Act, 1952, being chapter 80 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1952, is hereby amended.
- 2. Section 380, subsection (1) is amended by striking out amended the words "the twenty-fourth of May, or when that day falls upon a Sunday, the twenty-fifth day of May" and by substituting the words "Victoria Day".
