

Bill No. 105 of 1953

A BILL TO AMEND THE HORNED CATTLE
PURCHASES ACT

NOTE

This Bill amends *The Horned Cattle Purchases Act*, being chapter 94 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 2*a* is added and provides authority for the Minister of Agriculture, with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, to prescribe the sum to be deducted from the purchase price of horned cattle. This is limited to a sum not exceeding five dollars.

Section 3 is amended to delete the reference to the one dollar horned cattle charge and substitute a reference to the sum which will be prescribed by the Minister under the new section 2*a*.

Section 4 is amended for the same purpose and also to include trucked cattle where before reference was made only to cattle shipped by railway car, and to refer also to the Lethbridge stock yards where formerly a reference was made only to stock yards at Edmonton and Calgary.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of September, 1953.

An Act to amend The Horned Cattle Purchases Act

(Assented to _____, 1953)
HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows:

1. *The Horned Cattle Purchases Act*, being chapter 94 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. The following new section is added immediately after section 2: New section
2a

“**2a.** The Minister, with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, may prescribe from time to time a sum not exceeding five dollars a head as the sum which shall be deducted for the purposes of this Act from the purchase price of cattle with horns.” Purchase

3. Section 3, subsection (1) is amended Section 3
amended
(a) by striking out the words “of one dollar per head” and by substituting the words “prescribed by the Minister”;
(b) by striking out the words “of one dollar for each” and by substituting the words “prescribed by the Minister for each”.

4. Section 4 is amended Section 4
amended
(a) by striking out subsection (1) and by substituting the following:
“**4.** (1) No person shall ship any cattle with horns out of the Province by motor vehicle or by railway car unless the sum prescribed by the Minister is forwarded to the Minister.”; Shipment of
horned
cattle out of
Province
(b) by adding immediately after the words “any railway car”, where they occur in subsection (2), the words “or motor vehicle”;
(c) by striking out the words “or Calgary”, where they occur in subsection (2), and by substituting the words “, Calgary or Lethbridge”.

5. This Act comes into force on the first day of September, 1953. Coming into
