# A BILL TO AMEND THE BANFF FOUNDATION ACT

#### Note

This Bill amends *The Banff Foundation Act*, being chapter 22 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1947.

Section 6a is added. This new section provides authority for the Banff Foundation to receive and hold moneys charged with the payment of an annuity if certain conditions are complied with.

Section 6b is added. This section authorizes the Board of Governors of the University of Alberta to advance to the Foundation, as gifts or loans, sums required by it for the payment of annuities.

Section 6c declares that the due payment of annuities under section 6a is guaranteed by the Province, but moneys paid under this guarantee shall be repaid to the Provincial Treasurer by the Foundation and forms a first charge on the assets and revenues of the Foundation.

Section 7 is amended. The effect of this amendment to subsection (2) is to authorize the trustees of the Foundation to appoint additional trustees not being less than three nor more than seven in number. Subsection (5) is struck out. This placed a restriction on the re-election of trustees and is removed.

Section 8 is amended by the addition of a subsection (2) which provides that the trustees shall meet at least once a year on a date fixed by their chairman.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

# An Act to amend The Banff Foundation Act

(Assented to

, 1953)

THER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Banff Foundation Act, being chapter 22 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1947, is hereby amended.

New sections 6a, 6b, 6c

2. The following new sections are added immediately after section 6:

Annuities

- "Ga. (1) The Foundation may receive moneys by gift, bequest, transfer or otherwise for the payment of an annuity, equal to four per cent of the amount of the moneys so received, to a person designated by the donor, testator or transferor,
  - "(a) if the aggregate sum of all such moneys held by the Foundation does not exceed two hundred and fifty thousand dollars, and
  - "(b) if the annuity for which the moneys are held is for the period of one life only, and
  - "(c) if the property in the moneys is vested in the Foundation free of any other charge whatsoever, and
  - "(d) if the person designated as a recipient of an annuity has attained the age of fifty-five years
    - "(i) at the date of the gift or transfer of such moneys to the Foundation, or
    - "(ii) at the date of the death of the testator in the case of a bequest of such moneys to the Foundation.
- "(2) The Foundation may enter into any agreement necessary to the exercise of the powers given to the Foundation under subsection (1).

Advance to Foundation

" $\mathbf{6}b$ . The Governors may advance by way of gift or loan to the Foundation any sum or sums for the payment of which the Foundation may have become obligated under the provisions of section 6a.

Guarantee by

- "6c. (1) The due payment by the Foundation of all moneys payable by it pursuant to the provisions of section 6a is hereby guaranteed by the Province.
- "(2) Any moneys paid pursuant to the guarantee under subjection (1) shall be repaid by the Foundation to the

Provincial Treasurer on behalf of the Province and until repaid shall form a first charge on the assets and revenue of the Foundation.".

#### 3. Section 7 is amended

Section 7 amended

- (a) by striking out subsection (2) and by substituting the following:
  - "(2) The trustees for the time being shall from time to time appoint not less than three nor more than seven additional trustees.";
- (b) by striking out subsection (5).

#### 4. Section 8 is amended

Section 8 amended

- (a) by renumbering the section as subsection (1);
- (b) by adding immediately after subsection (1) the following new subsection:
  - "(2) The trustees shall meet at least once a year Meeting of on a date to be fixed by the chairman of the trustees.".
- **5.** This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is  $\frac{\text{Coming}}{\text{force}}$  into assented to.
