A BILL TO AMEND THE ALBERTA GOVERNMENT PURCHASING AGENCY ACT

Note

This Bill amends *The Alberta Government Purchasing Agency Act*, being chapter 19 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 2 is amended. Clause (e) is struck out and a new clause (e) substituted. All reference in the definition of "supplies" to advertising is removed as government advertising in future will be handled by the Publicity Bureau of the Department of Economic Affairs.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Alberta Government Purchasing Agency Act, being chapter 19 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.
- **2.** Section 2 is amended by striking out clause (e) and $\frac{Section 2}{amended}$ by substituting the following:
 - "(e) 'supplies' means all goods, wares and merchandise "supplies" required by any department for the transaction of its business and affairs, and without derogating from the generality of the foregoing includes all furnishings, whether fixtures or otherwise, all equipment and all stationery;".
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is $\frac{\text{Coming into}}{\text{force}}$ assented to.
