An Act for Granting to Her Majesty Certain Sums of Money for the Public Service for the Fiscal Years Ending Respectively the Thirty-first Day of March, 1953, the Thirty-first day of March, 1954, and the Thirty-first Day of March, 1955.

(Assented to , 1954)

Most Gracious Sovereign:

WHEREAS it appears by Messages from His Honour John J. Bowlen, Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Alberta, and the Estimates accompanying the said Messages, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Public Service of Alberta not otherwise provided for during the financial periods ending respectively the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-three; the thirty-first day of March, one thousand, nine hundred and fifty-four; and the thirty-first day of March, one thousand, nine hundred and fifty-five, and for other purposes relating thereto;

Preamble

May it therefore please Your Majesty that it be enacted, and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Appropriation Act, 1954*".

Short title

2. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole one hundred and fifty-three thousand, three hundred and seventy-three dollars and seventy-nine cents, towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of April, one thousand, nine hundred and fifty-two, to the thirty-first day of March, one thousand, nine hundred and fifty-three, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule A to this Act.

Appropriation for 1952-1953

3. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole, six million, six hundred and ninety-nine thousand, eight hundred and seventy-two dollars and fifty-four cents, towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of April, one thousand, nine hundred and fifty-three, to the thirty-first day of March, one thousand, nine hundred and fifty-four, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule B to this Act.

4. From and out of the General Revenue Fund, there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole one hundred and seventy-eight million, five hundred thousand, five hundred and seventy-two dollars, towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the public service from the first day of April, one thousand, nine hundred and fifty-four, to the thirty-first day of March, one thousand, nine hundred and fifty-five, not otherwise provided for, and set forth in Schedule C to this Act.

Account-ability for

5. The due application of all moneys expended under this Act shall be accounted for.

6. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
