A BILL TO REPEAL THE POST-WAR RECONSTRUCTION FUND ACT

NOTE

This Bill repeals The Post-War Reconstruction Fund Act, being chapter 9 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1943.

Section 2 provides for moneys or securities remaining in that fund when the Act is repealed. Such moneys or securities are to be transferred to the General Revenue Fund by the Provincial Treasurer.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of July, 1954.

An Act to repeal The Post-War Reconstruction Fund Act

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Post-War Reconstruction Fund Act, being chapter Repeal 9 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1943, is hereby repealed.
- 2. Upon the coming into force of this Act, the Provincial Transfer General Revenue Treasurer

Fund

- (a) shall deposit in the General Revenue Fund all moneys then held in "The Post-war Reconstruction Fund", and
- (b) shall transfer to the credit of the General Revenue Fund any securities in which any portion of "The Post-war Reconstruction Fund" is then invested.
- 3. This Act comes into force on the first day of July, 1954. Coming into force
