

Bill No. 20 of 1954

A BILL TO AMEND THE CHILD WELFARE ACT

NOTE

This Bill amends *The Child Welfare Act*, being chapter 8 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1944.

Subsection (14) of section 14 is struck out and a new subsection substituted. This subsection provides a rule whereby the residence of a neglected child may be determined. The new subsection more clearly sets out the rule to determine residence; with the former subsection different interpretations were made.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

An Act to amend The Child Welfare Act

(Assented to _____, 1954)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Child Welfare Act*, being chapter 8 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1944, is hereby amended.

2. Section 14 is amended by striking out subsection (14) and by substituting the following: Section 14
amended

“(14) For the purposes of this section,

“(a) if the parents of a child are residing together the child shall be deemed to be a resident of that municipality in which the parents are residents as determined by the appropriate municipal Act relating to indigent persons,

Determin-
ing residence

“(b) if the parents of a child are not residing together, the child shall be deemed to be a resident of that municipality in which

“(i) the parent, or

“(ii) the legal guardian, having the actual custody of the child is a resident as determined by the appropriate municipal Act relating to indigent persons.”.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to. Coming into
