

Bill No. 26 of 1954

A BILL TO AMEND THE SEIZURES ACT

NOTE

This Bill amends *The Seizures Act*, being chapter 143 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 3 is amended so that distress warrants under *The Masters and Servants Act* may be executed in the same manner as other process. Previously it was necessary to engage police officers to execute such distress warrants.

This Bill comes into force on the first day of July, 1954.

An Act to amend The Seizures Act

(Assented to , 1954)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Seizures Act*, being chapter 143 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. Section 3 is amended

amended

- (a) by renumbering the section as subsection (1) ;
- (b) by striking out the words "nor to any power of distress" where they occur in subsection (1) and by substituting the words "nor, subject to subsection (2), to any power of distress";
- (c) by adding immediately after subsection (1) the following new subsection:

"(2) The provisions of this Act apply to a power of distress to enforce the payment of any money payable under an order made pursuant to *The Masters and Servants Act*."
