Section 4 is amended by adding a new clause (aa). The purpose of this clause is to confer on a judge of the Family Court jurisdiction in matters arising under The Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Act.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Family Court Act, being chapter 32 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1952, is hereby amended.
- 2. Section 4 is amended by adding immediately after section 4 clause (a) the following new clause:
- "(aa) maintenance orders for deserted wives and families made against any person by a court in a reciprocating state and enforceable under *The Maintenance Orders* (Facilities for Enforcement) Act;".
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is coming assented to.
