A BILL TO AMEND THE FAMILY COURT ACT

NOTE

This Bill amends *The Family Court Act*, being chapter 32 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1952.

Section 4 is amended by adding a new clause (aa). The purpose of this clause is to confer on a judge of the Family Court jurisdiction in matters arising under *The Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Act*.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

# BILL

No. 29 of 1954

An Act to amend The Family Court Act

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1954)

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Family Court Act*, being chapter 32 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1952, is hereby amended.

2. Section 4 is amended by adding immediately after clause (a) the following new clause: **Section 4 amended**

“(aa) maintenance orders for deserted wives and families made against any person by a court in a reciprocating state and enforceable under *The Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Act*.”

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to. **Coming into force**
