

Bill No. 37 of 1954

A BILL TO AMEND THE WILLS ACT

NOTE

This Bill amends *The Wills Act*, being chapter 210 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 6 is amended to permit a minor who has made a will while a member of the army, navy or air force on actual service, or while at sea or in the course of a voyage to revoke his will while still a minor and after he has finished his actual service or voyage.

Section 6*a* is added to the Act to permit a minor of nineteen years of age or over and married to make a valid will.

This Bill is to come into force upon assent.

An Act to amend The Wills Act

(Assented to , 1954)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Wills Act*, being chapter 210 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. Section 6 is amended by adding immediately after subsection (3) the following new subsection:

“(4) An infant who has made a will on actual service or at sea or in the course of a voyage and who is no longer on actual service or at sea or in the course of a voyage may revoke his will in any manner permitted by clauses (b) and (c) of section 16.”.

3. The following new section is added immediately after section 6:

“**6a.** An infant of the age of nineteen years or over who is married may make a valid will in any of the forms permitted by this Act.”.

4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
