

Bill No. 45 of 1954

A BILL TO AMEND THE EXECUTION CREDITORS
ACT

NOTE

This Bill amends *The Execution Creditors Act*, being chapter 122 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 19, subsection (4) is struck out and a new subsection (4) is substituted. This subsection now provides that where goods are held under seizure by the sheriff, notice of proceedings by another claimant is to be filed with the sheriff as well as with the clerk or deputy clerk of the court. Previously there was no provision requiring filing of such a notice with the sheriff.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

An Act to amend The Execution Creditors Act

(Assented to _____, 1954)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Execution Creditors Act*, being chapter 122 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. Section 19 is amended by striking out subsection (4) and by substituting the following: Section 19 amended

“(4) The claimant shall file a duplicate of the affidavit of claim and a copy of the notice with an affidavit of service thereof in Form D in the Schedule Filing of affidavit of claim and notice

“(a) with the clerk or deputy clerk of the District Court of the district the sheriff of which has the execution, and

“(b) with the sheriff of the district who has the execution in his hands.”.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to. Coming into force
