Bill No. 55 of 1954

A BILL TO AMEND THE HOME FOR AGED OR INFIRM ACT

Note

This Bill amends The Home for Aged or Infirm Act, being chapter 14 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1945.

A new section 4*a* is added. Subsection (1) enables the Minister with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council to pay to a municipality that provides for the erection or purchase of a home with ten beds or more for the aged or infirm a grant of one-third of the cost thereof or five hundred dollars a bed, whichever is the lesser. Previously there was no provision for such assistance. Subsection (2) provides that the Lieutenant Governor in Council may make regulations respecting the manner in which such a home is to be equipped and operated.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

An Act to amend The Home for Aged or Infirm Act

(Assented to , 1954)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Home for Aged or Infirm Act, being chapter 14 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1945, is hereby amended.

2. The following new section is added immediately after New section 4a

"4a. (1) With the approval of the Lieutenant Governor Grant to in Council the Minister may pay to a municipality that erects or purchases a building and equips it with ten beds or more for use as a home for the aged or infirm, a grant of an amount equal to one-third of the cost thereof or five hundred dollars a bed, whichever is the lesser.

"(2) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may make Regulations regulations respecting the manner in which a home referred to in subsection (1) is to be equipped and operated.".

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it Coming is assented to.
