

Bill No. 75 of 1954

A BILL TO AMEND THE TAX RECOVERY ACT

NOTE

This Bill amends *The Tax Recovery Act*, being chapter 161 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 22 is amended by adding a new subsection (1a) which provides that where a parcel sold has lost its identity as a result of a cancellation of a subdivision and as a result of a resurvey or either of them, the parcel sold is to be transferred by the form of transfer provided in *The Land Titles Act*.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of July, 1954.

An Act to amend The Tax Recovery Act

(Assented to _____, 1954)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Tax Recovery Act*, being chapter 161 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. Section 22 is amended by adding immediately after subsection (1) the following new subsection: Section 22
amended

"(1a) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1), when the parcel sold has lost its identity as a result of a cancellation of the subdivision and as a result of a resurvey of the subdivision or as a result of either, the parcel sold shall be transferred by the form of transfer provided in *The Land Titles Act*."
